Academy of Management Discoveries (AMD) -- the journal for empirical
exploration in management and organizations -- invites you to its regional paper
development workshop. The purpose of this workshop is to help authors develop
their ideas for papers that may ultimately be submitted for review in *AMD*.

AMD is currently listed on the Emerging Sources of Citation Index and is expected
to receive a top-tier journal impact factor within the next 2 years.

About the Workshop:

This event will include a presentation by *AMD*'s editor, **PETER BAMBERGER**.
Hands-on paper development discussions will follow the plenary session.

Presentation topics include:

- Abductive (as opposed to deductive and inductive) reasoning as a necessary basis for research in management and organizations
- Plausibility vs. Confirmation, and the distinctive nature of *AMD* papers.
- Surfacing phenomenon: Phenomenology and scale development research in *AMD*
- Meta-analysis and replication research in *AMD*
- Using big/secondary data as a basis for theoretical insight
- How to maximize the odds of paper acceptance in *AMD*

Roundtable paper development sessions:

- Feedback on papers that authors are considering for submission to Academy of Management Discoveries
- Discussions will focus on framing, methodological rigor, empirical follow-up, interpretation, and specifying directions for down-the-road theorizing
- **Discussions are open to both paper authors and non-author participants**

As space is limited, preference will be given first to those whose papers are being discussed in the roundtables. Additional spots will be allocated on the basis of first come, first served.

- Those who wish to have their paper reviewed and discussed should submit an extended abstract (between 5 and 10 pages of text) of their papers or paper ideas by ***JUNE 10, 2019***. Abstracts will be accepted on a competitive basis.
- We encourage authors to submit their paper/abstract as soon as possible. While the deadline for the AMD workshop is June 10, authors of submissions received by April 10 will receive notification of a decision before April 15, the last day for early-bird registration.
- The abstract should provide a synopsis of the research question, its relevance and significance, a statement relating to the limited ability of extant concepts and/or theory to provide a coherent response to that question, the empirical approach, and the implications of the findings for down-the-road theorizing.
- Extended abstracts should be about 10 pages, double spaced, excluding tables, figures and references. To upload your abstract at a later date, click 'EDIT SUBMISSION' from your confirmation email.
- Before you submit your extended abstract please make sure that your extended abstract is appropriate for AMD by reading AMD's Mission Statement and Principles and the FAQ's.
- You may also view the AMD Workshop Experience video.
- Those who wish to participate in the workshop without submitting a paper for review and discussion need only register (Select "Attending without submitting an abstract" on the form).
- **Paper feedback sessions are open to all**, but discussions will revolve around papers submitted and accepted for discussion at the workshop.

Transportation: The nearest airport is Denpasar (DPS). Officially, it is the I Gusti Ngurah Rai International Airport (in Bahasa Indonesia: *Bandar Udara Internasional Ngurah Rai*). It is the main airport in Bali, and the second busiest in Indonesia (behind the Jakarta airport). DPS has direct air links throughout Indonesia and Southeast Asia. It also has excellent air links to major cities throughout the Pacific Rim and Australasia. DPS is only 5-10 minutes by car from The Patra Bali.

Entry and Visa Requirements: Please note that you are responsible for making sure if you can travel to Bali without a visa. Otherwise, you will need to apply for a visa.
