Submissions approved for inclusion in the workshop will be those judged to make potentially significant and novel theoretical and empirical contributions to the field.

The workshop is a one-and-a-half day event and will include presentations by *AMJ*'s editorial team, as well as presentations and roundtable discussions from participants. Participation in the workshop is by application only. In order to maximize the number of projects discussed at the event, only one author per project will be able to attend. **Interested scholars should submit an extended abstract (between 5 and 10 pages of text) of their project proposal by February 1, 2018 to Jason D. Shaw, Editor-in-Chief (jason.shaw@polyu.edu.hk).** The abstract should describe the project, the intended theoretical contribution, the research design, the empirical approach, and the status of the project idea to date.
