


- Networking and connection occurs through the **DIVISIONS and INTEREST GROUPS** which are the intellectual and social maps of the Academy


- Name badges are provided to all registered attendees. All attendees must wear official conference name badges to all Annual Meeting sessions, workshops, receptions, and events.
